Officer Devarona began working as a school resource officer this year at Biscayne Elementary School. As liaison between the school and police department, Officer Devarona provides security, traffic control, and teaches students important safety lessons. He volunteered his time and effort to paint all six staircases (159 steps) with multiplication tables 1 through 12 so students waiting in line or walking up the stairs can practice and learn their multiplication tables after seeing the stairs artistically enhanced with math graffiti.

The School Board appreciates the efforts of Carlos Devarona for keeping our schools safe and making sure students learn their multiplication tables. His commitment to the well-being of the students, parents, and families of Miami-Dade County Public Schools is evident and his efforts are truly appreciated.
